Instructions: Improve the design of this handout by changing and rearranging the elements below. The purpose of the handout is to help students compare the meanings of similar vocabulary words.

Word 1: Melancholy (noun)

Definition: a gloomy state of mind, especially when habitual or prolonged; depression.

Word 1: Sadness

Definition: the condition of feeling sorrow or grief.

“John was overcome with sadness when his dog suddenly died.”
